



FOOD BANK PICK UP VOLUNTEER

About Us: Closer to Home Community Services (CTH) is a Calgary and Airdrie based not-for-profit agency that delivers a variety of services designed to meet the needs of vulnerable children and their families. Be a part of an innovative team that envisions:

About the Position: The Food Bank Pick-Up Volunteer assists Closer to Home Community Services (CTH) by picking up a variety of perishable and non-perishable food items from the Calgary Food Bank and bringing the donations to the CTH West Central Resource Centre (the volunteer is responsible for loading and unloading the items into their vehicle). The volunteer also assists CTH staff and volunteers with sorting and storing the items so that they can be used by the clients of CTH programs and services. This volunteer position requires that the volunteer is available on Mondays from 10.00am until 1.00pm.

About You: You are a dedicated individual who has a desire to contribute to your community. You can work independently and demonstrate excellent problem solving skills. You have the ability to lift, carry and move a variety of items of varying weights. You possess strong verbal communication skills and have a positive attitude. You enjoy working as part of a team and understand the importance of collaboration and support in a team environment.

The Food Bank Pick-Up Volunteer must be 18 years or older. The successful volunteer must have a valid Alberta Driver's License, adequate and current insurance (minimum \$1 million in third party liability coverage required) and be willing to provide a driver's abstract upon hire. The volunteer must also have access to a vehicle that is reliable and roadworthy and suitable for transporting large quantities of perishable and non-perishable food items. All CTH volunteers must complete a Police Information Check and an Intervention Record Check prior to becoming a volunteer with the organization.
